Tommy Peyton, Jr. is a 50 year old father of 3 teenagers. In January 2010 he was diagnosed with 4th stage Non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma "with Leukemia phase. Tommy was let go from his accounting job, losing his company insurance. He is now self employed and at this time can not work. After they were dropped from the company insurance and Cobra expired, the only insurance that would cover him, was the Mississippi Risk Pool Insurance. Tommy traveled to M.D. Anderson after his initial diagnosis and started treatment. At this time, he is no longer financially able to go to M.D.Anderson and is being treated at a hospital in Hattiesburg. Tommy and his wife Patti are now responsible for 20% of every bill as well as the high insurance premium The hospital bills, including an emergency appendectomy and spinal tap amount to over \$20,000. Tommy is in a 2 year treatment program with the hope that he goes into remission. The Peyton family has been medically, mentally and financially challenged and are in need of your support.
